

2021 ANNUAL STAKEHOLDER MEETING TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 9TH 6:00 PM - 8:00 PM



Tuesday, November 9th community members and experts across the state of Colorado will gather virtually to share your struggles with insurance, medication or any other issues that you have been facing.

There will be two portions to this meeting with a short break in between. Throughout the first portion of this meeting, expert organizations and pharma partners will join us to share information for discussions on state and federal policy issues and trends that currently are, or may in the future, impact the bleeding disorders community. The second portion will be a closed session to those directly in the bleeding disorders community. Here we will discuss the results of the 2021 Needs Survey and use those conversations to consider long-term priorities, and develop strategies with action plans that ensure continued access to quality, patient-centered treatment care remains available for our rare patient population.



NEW COVID-19 GUIDELINES

Starting **October 1, 2021**, NHF and national chapter face to face meetings and events (indoors and outdoors) will require that all attendees, including NHF staff and sponsors aged 12 and older, show proof of being fully vaccinated or a negative COVID-19 test within 72 hours of attending the event. Additionally, for indoor events, all attendees must wear masks regardless of vaccination status. NHF strongly recommends that all attendees wear masks at outdoor events as well, but hosts should follow the strictest guidelines – either CDC, local, regional or state quidelines.
